**ORDER**


CA 1460/2019 has been filed by the RP praying for extension of the CIR period. The 180 days expired on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2019. As per the resolution passed by the COC in its meeting convened on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2019, this matter was taken up as Item No. 1 on the Agenda and has been approved by 66% in terms of the voting power directing the RP to seek further extension of 90 days of the CIR period. The application is duly annexed with the affidavit of the RP. He has apprised this Bench that a resolution plan is under consideration.

Keeping in view the stage of the resolution, this Bench is of the opinion that extension is required. The CIR period is therefore extended beyond 180 days by another 90 days. The RP is directed to take expeditious steps and file his periodic reports.
